

Mystery 2011

Here are some cutting and sewing instructions for the Mystery Class that you will want to do before the class.

Cutting: You may want to use a little starch on the fabric before cutting your strips.

Light – Cut 3 – 2 ½” strips

Medium light – Cut 6 – 2 ½” strips

Medium – Cut 9 – 2 ½” strips

Medium dark – Cut 12 – 2 ½” strips

Dark – Cut 15 – 2 ½” strips – Cut three of the strips into 48 – 2 ½” squares

Very Dark – Cut 16 – 2 ½” strips. Cut 8 of these into 196 – 2 ½” triangles using the Easy Angle Ruler.

Yardage Correction - If you want to do Stack-n-Whack with the focus fabric you will need 4 repeats of at least an 18” repeat plus 1 yard for the outside border. This needs to be a large print with several colors and different shapes in it. For stacking – first cut off the 1 yard and put aside. Then tear the remaining piece with the 4 repeats along the fold. Sewing:

Sew together 6 sets of strips that go Medium Light, Medium and Medium Dark. Press three of these sets toward the dark and label them A. Press the remaining three sets toward the light and label them B.

Sew together 6 strip sets of Medium Dark and Dark. Press three of these sets toward the dark and label them C. Press the remaining three toward the light and label them D.
